I, PATTY SMITH HILL, residing in the Borough of Manhattan of the City of New York, State of New York, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be a First Codicil to my Last Will and Testament bearing date and subscribed by me on the ninth day of June, 1945, that is to say:

FIRST: I hereby revoke the bequest made to my housekeeper, CORA L. KENNEY, by subdivision "h" of paragraph "THIRD" of my said Last Will and Testament, and in lieu thereof make the following bequest to her in form and words as follows:

h. I give and bequeath to CORA L. KENNEY of New York City, my housekeeper for many years, the sum of five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars if she shall survive me and provided, further she shall have remained faithful to me and in my employ at the time of my decease; the said bequest of five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars to be paid to her in five (5) annual instalments of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars each, of which the first such instalment shall be paid to her seven months after the date of the qualification of my Executor and annually thereafter; but if the said CORA L. KENNEY shall have died prior to the date when any instalment shall become payable then and upon the happening of such event all unmatured instalments shall revert to and become part of my residuary estate to be disposed of as I in my said Last Will and Testament have directed.

SECOND: Except as hereby revoked I ratify, confirm and approve each and every other provision contained in my Last Will and Testament.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have subscribed this, a First Codicil to my Last Will and Testament, at New York City, on the 3 day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
