
TO HONORABLE JOHN F. O'CONNELL, JUDGE OF THE PROBATE COURT OF COOK COUNTY:

Your petitioner, Leo B. Lowenthal, respectfully represents unto this court as follows:

1. That on May 14, 1923 Corinne Dorothy Hill filed her petition herein for proof of the will of WILLIAM WALLACE HILL, deceased and for issuance of letters testamentary; that letters testamentary were granted to said Corinne Dorothy Hill and that she acted as said Executrix of the estate of William Wallace Hill from said date until her death on September 27, 1934; that your petitioner filed his appearance as attorney for said Corinne Dorothy Hill on May 14, 1923 and acted as said attorney until the death of said Corinne Dorothy Hill; that the death of said Executrix was suggested to this court on February 1, 1939, by your petitioner and that day Allen Davy was appointed administrator de bonis non with will annexed; that on February 1, 1939 an order was entered authorizing the withdrawal of the appearance of your petitioner as attorney for said Corinne Dorothy Hill and that on said date your petitioner withdrew as said attorney.
2. Your petitioner further represents that in his capacity as attorney for said Corinne Dorothy Hill in her

capacity as Executrix of said estate, he performed numerous necessary legal services in connection with the administration of said estate; that he expended a large number of hours in connection with the drawing and presentation of the petition for probate of the last will and testament of William Wallace Hill and for letters testamentary, the proof of heirship in the estate of William Wallace Hill, in the drawing and presentation of the several petitions heretofore presented to this court in relation to the administration of said estate and in advising said Executrix as to her duties in connection with the administration of said estate; that your petitioner has never received any fee or compensation whatsoever for his services as attorney for said Executrix; that the fair, reasonable and usual fee for the services so rendered is in excess of the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars.

WHEREFORE your petitioner prays that an order be entered herein fixing the fees of your petitioner and allowing your petitioner's claim for such fees as a first class claim ^{to be paid} in due course of administration.
